LEARN TO IDENTIFY THE BARRIERS

Diagnostic teaching is one approach that can help pinpoint what may be going wrong if your student is struggling. The big idea is to identify precisely why your child might be struggling: Is it focus? Motivation? Too much or too little structure? Do they need a hug or for you to sit with them? Is it a knowledge deficit?

If it's a knowledge deficit, exactly what do they not understand? When students say, 'I don't get it,' the first step is to identify exactly what 'it' is—and this isn't always easy. Most students don't know what they don't know.

That's why you (and an internet full of resources, including contacting the teacher) are there to help them identify why they are getting stuck and how they can get past it. This an especially powerful remote learning tip to bridge for successful student learning.
