Kuna High School Families:

This is a really exciting time for Kuna High School students. Thanks to the Kuna community passing the 2017 bond, we built a state-of-the-art facility -- Swan Falls High School -- that will support learning and career exploration for Kuna School District students.

As you know, Swan Falls was designed to be built in phases to meet our students' needs as our community grows. Depending on community support in the future, other phases will be built, and Swan Falls will become a comprehensive high school like Kuna High School.

In this first phase, Swan Falls will be an extension or satellite location for our students (and Initial Point, too) to take general education and career and technical education classes based on their schedule choices.

The administration and management of the school is under Kuna High, with Brian Graves as the principal and Robbie Reno as the onsite lead building administrator at SFHS.

We're excited for our students to benefit from this community investment. This letter answers some questions as we gear up for students to take classes at Swan Falls with the start of the second quarter, Nov. 2.

If your student is taking classes at SF they are still considered a Kuna High School student.

Frequently asked questions:

What classes will be taught at SFHS?

Swan Falls will offer general education and Career Technical Education (CTE) classes. Swan Falls provides more general classroom spaces and allows us to expand our CTE offerings and upgrade facilities and equipment for other programs moving to SFHS. Here's what's being offered at the Swan Falls location:

CTE Programs at SFHS

- Health Occupations (EMT/ Dental Assistant/ Nursing Assistant and Athletic Training)
- Construction Trades & Management
- Diesel Technology
- Auto Technology
- Electronics Technology

CTE Programs at KHS

- Agriculture/Natural Resources & Welding
- Business and Management
- Information Technology & Broadcasting
- Family and Consumer Sciences
- Engineering

JROTC will also continue to be located at KHS.

How do I know if I have a SF class?

You can log into your TylerSIS. Go to my schedule. On your schedule the classroom will say SF. SF indicates Swan Falls. If there is no SF, your class is at KHS. Most students are at SFHS for half the day with transfer time built in during lunch. Below is a sample student schedule with classes at both schools.

When will classes begin at SFHS?

Classes will begin on November 2nd - the first day of the second condensed quarter.

How will my student get to SFHS?

A transfer bus will travel between the schools. There will be before school, lunch, and after school bus transfers. The transfer bus schedule is below:

- AM bus KHS to Swan Falls - 7:15am
- Lunch Transfer from both schools- 11:15am
- PM transfer Swan Falls to KHS - 2:30pm

Can my student drive to SFHS?

Do they need a separate parking permit for SFHS?

No. The KHS parking pass works at both schools.
