Office News

There are a very limited number of parking spots left in student parking. If you would like to purchase a parking pass, please bring your car registration, driver's license, and \$30 to the office during lunch time only. Also, the following areas do not allow student parking: Church parking lot (if you do not have a seminary parking pass), District parking lot, Freemont Middle School parking lot, Staff parking in the front of the school, Kay Street, Porter Street, the dirt areas on the road across the street from the school on Deer Flat. If you park in these areas, you run the risk of being ticketed or towed.

Students – The bookkeeper is open for payments before school and during lunch and Intervention ONLY! Please, schedule your time wisely and make payments only during these times.

Parking

Students – Please remember to follow the rules in the parking lot as outlined in the student handbook.

-Drivers must drive in a responsible manner. Inattentive or irresponsible driving will not be tolerated and will be subject to fines and/or loss of driving privileges. This includes speeding, rapid acceleration, racing, burning tires or making illegal turns in the parking lot.

-Vehicles must be legally parked in the student parking lot in the spot they have purchased. Students may not switch parking spots with another student!

-Students may not loiter in their cars or in the parking lot before and after school or during lunch.

-Vandalism constitutes grounds to have parking privileges revoked.

-Students may not park in areas designated as visitor parking, faculty or staff parking, handicapped parking or in areas with curbs painted yellow or red, nor are they allowed to park in a spot they have not paid for.

-Vehicles must have a KHS parking permit that is displayed on the rear-view mirror of the vehicle to be able to park on campus.

Driving and/or parking violations are subject to the following consequences at the discretion of administration:

- 1st offense - Verbal or written warnings
- 2nd offense - suspension of parking privileges or fines
- 3rd offense - suspension of parking privileges/school or vehicle towed

Further offenses - parking privileges may be revoked for an indeterminate amount of time.

Remember – parking @ KHS is a privilege, not a right! Please keep our parking lots safe for all students to enjoy.
